Founding Jamestown

•	1607- group of wealthy pooled resources- founded
•	Wanted to get a share of American riches – Gold or silver, fur trade, lumber, vinyards
•	King James I- gave merchants a (an official document that gives a person or group certain rights or priveleges) to found the Virginia colony
•	1607- 100 men landed in Chesapeake- built fort they called 1st permanent English settlement
•	Problems: - built in a filled with malaria spread
