- The British Surrender
 - Sept 1781- 1600 American and French troops laid to Cornwallis' 8,000
 - Siege- when an army surrounds and blockades an enemy position in an attempt to capture it
 - Cornwallis held out- death toll rose, supplies droppedfinally ______ and lost Battle of Yorktown
 - October 19, 1781- Brits surrender weapons- marched between a line of Americans and French
