The Nation Looks West

- After the Revolution, more people began
- By 1800, 1 million ppl lived btw Apps and MS River
 - Ppl relied on MS River to ______
 - Spain had threatened to close port of New Orleans to Americans

- 1795-

Americans could ship goods down MS to New Orleans to be stored until moved onto larger ships to head east

• 1801- Spain had given Louisiana to France- TJeff feared

Buying Louisiana

- A Surprise Offer
 - Jefferson thought the best action was to
 - Sent ______ to negotiate the purchase from Napoleon
 - At the time, France had
 - France was also about to go to war with Britain again
 - Napoleon needed money- offered to
 - Monroe risked not asking TJeff first (would take months) and just went for it-

Buying Lousiana

- Jefferson's Dilemma
 - A good deal for America- more than doubled its size for 4 cents an acre
 - BUT,

- He reasoned, the land was bought
 _____- a right the president did
 - have
- Congress approved it and authorized payment

- 1803 (before LA purchase)- Congress approved \$2500 for westward expedition
- Jefferson chose an army cptn

, who . an

officer to go with him

chose

- They were to report back the physical geography, plants, and animals of the west
 - Other goals: make friends with Natives in LA territory and find a waterway from MS River to Pacific

- Spring of 1804- 3 boats, 40 men left
 _____ on MO River
 - Plenty of supplies
 - Most American, some French Canadians and one slave named York
- By mid July they hit the Platte River (MO River tributary)
- Early August they met the 1st Natives
- Late August they reached the eastern edge of the Great Plains

- Oct 1804, made winter camp with Mandan people of North Dakota
 - met a French Canadian and his Shoshone wife,
 - Sacajawea would then travel with L&S as

- Crossing the Rockies
 - April 1805- L&S continued and got to what is now Montana- began crossing the Rockies
 - By August they reached the Continental Divide
 (

- L&S ran into a group of Shoshones- turned out the chief was Sacajawea's brother
 - He agreed to give ______ to L&S to help them continue to cross mountains

- At the Pacific
 - After crossing the Rockies, they reached the
 - Stopped to build canoes- had to go through miles of rapids
 - By November 1805 they reached the Pacific
 - Spent the winter there, headed back in March of 1806- took half a year to get back

explored

- Pike's Expedition
 - 1806-1807southern LA Territory
 - Made it to the Rockies- tried to climb a mountain that looked east over the Great Plains
 - Had to turn back 2/3 down when up to his waist in snow
 - Now known as

His return took him through Spanish NM where he was

- Later he was released and escorted back to US
- His reports generated interest by Americans in the Spanish territories
