American Neutrality is Challenged

- 1803- Britain and France at war again
- US tried to stay neutral
- Britain and France were raiding US ships- over 1500 between 1803 and 1807
 - British impressment of sailors to fight in military

Jefferson Responds with an Embargo

- Didn't work- ______ instead
 Exports dropped for \$109m to \$25m in one year
 Crop prices ______, tens of thousands
 Americans very angry- especially in New England

 People began smuggling

- 1809- Congress repeals Embargo Act- passes less severe law opening trade with countries except Britain and France
 - Would reopen trade with them once they respected American trade rights as neutral country

Tecumseh and the Prophet

- New Leaders Take Charge
 - Hit Shawnee hard
 - 1805- 2 Shawnee bros-

Tecumseh and the Prophet

- Harrison's Victory
 - Americans disturbed by Tecumseh
 - 1811- governor Indiana,

thousand soldiers against Shawnee villages on Tippecanoe River

- Defeated Native Americans in
- High point of Native defiance of American settlement-Tecumseh and followers would continue fighting for years
