- Sent into Exile
 - 722bc- Assyrians ______(to force to line in another place or country) resistant Israelites
 - Assyrians controlled Judah until 612bc when the Chaldeans conquered Assyria
 - Chaldean Babylonians controlled Judah
 - 587 bc- Judah king rebelled against Chaldeans
 - Chaldean Babylonian kingdestroyed Jerusalem and the temple and exiled people of Judah to Babylonia
